Interim Pastor Brian's Message

Call Committee Moving Forward by Interim Pastor Brian Brandt

The Call Committee has begun its work. They met with Pastor Susan Kintner, the Bishop's Assistant, on January 20. Pastor Kintner briefed them on the basics of the call process. Call Committee members had a chance to ask questions and get answers. Having attended that first meeting, it looks to me like their work is well begun. At their second meeting on January 27, Chris Reger was elected Chairperson of the Call Committee. Congratulations, Chris!



At the first meeting we learned that Pastor Kintner did not yet have names of clergy candidates for SOV. When she visited SOV last December, Pastor Kintner suggested she might have some names for us in January, but it didn't turn out that way. She did promise, however, to bring names of candidates to the Call Committee on March 15. That means interviewing will take place somewhat later than I speculated in last month's newsletter. But it's not a huge delay. There's reason to hope that a new pastor could be in place by mid-to-late summer. Again, that's just speculation — only time will tell what God has in store.

Congregations waiting to call a new pastor are often like little kids waiting for Santa to come. It's hard to wait, but please be patient. You've got a good Call Committee. They will do their best to move quickly. But they'll also do their due diligence and do a good job for you. SOV needs the right pastor; only patient, careful discernment will serve well to find that person.

While the Call Committee waits for names they have preparatory work to do. They'll study the Ministry Site Profile, the surveys we did last summer, and other materials so they are well-informed when they begin conversation with clergy candidates. There are interview questions to formulate and maybe some practice interviews to conduct. This time between now and March 15 will be well used. Easter is on March 27, so the Call Committee will likely to be ready to move on with another phase of the process soon after Easter.

This will probably be the last time I write at length about the work of the Call Committee. They will keep the congregation informed of their work as God gives them guidance. May God bless them in their ministry, for the good of SOV and for the glory of God.




