Interim Pastor Tom's Message

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

"Birds of a feather flock together". Human beings are no different. We tend to "hang out" with people that we know and care about. This is true also in a congregation. At coffee hour or at potlucks, people will tend to be in the same groupings, time after time. There's also the grouping that happens with the "early service people" and the "late service people". This is all perfectly natural and "ok".



There are negatives, however. We may go for years without ever getting to know someone that we see at church all the time. Even with people we think we know, we have yet to learn much about their lives.

At times, this lack of knowledge about each other can even grow into distrust and suspicions. Quite often, this happens only because we don't know what is going on in each other's lives.

There are some things that we can do to remedy these kind of situations. Talk to someone you don't know well at coffee hour. Sit with someone you don't know well at a fellowship event. Go to the "other service" just to catch up with what's going on with people. Invite some one to coffee or lunch to get to know them better. There will be many benefits for our congregation and for each other.

On a related note, if you notice that someone hasn't been in church for a while, contact them and ask them how they are doing. Don't make it about coming back to church, though. Make it about catching up since you haven't talked in a while.

Sometimes, if people are having difficulties in their personal lives, or in their church life, people may drop out of worship just "to see if any one will notice". Hopefully the Pastor will notice and make some kind of contact. The people who are "taking a break" will probably think that that's what the Pastor is supposed to do. "That's her or his job".

But it's different, and often more meaningful, if others also notice and reach out.

Ask yourself, "Who do I not know very well in my church? Who haven't I seen for awhile?" Reach out. It will benefit them, you, and us.


