Sources of funds through March 31, 2018 for the trip:


SOV operating budget \$2,000 12%

The specific changes recommended will be identified in the email.

I continue to feel we have so much to offer. Pastor's message is thought provoking, funny and relevant. Our beautiful music continues to add to the worship experience.
